



## Post-Microblading Instructions...

Do nothing to care for your brows until the next morning following your first service.

For the first 3 days- carefully dab your brows with a clean cotton pad with water only three times a day.

For the fourth and fifth day, carefully dab your brows with a clean cotton pad with water only twice a day.

On the sixth day- using an antibacterial soap such as the gold dial, make lather with water on your fingertips and very gently cleanse your brows with your hands- no washcloths. We recommend no washcloths until you are entirely healed.

If you'd like... LIGHTLY apply coconut oil (we will give you some) three times a day for three days. Then twice daily for four days. Coconut oil is not a required step. It may just make your healing more comfortable. **DO NOT USE NEOSPORIN! IT WILL LIFT THE PIGMENT!**

**During the first 5 days be careful not to let the shower hit your brows directly. Stay out of direct sunlight; wear a hat or large sunglasses to protect your brows. Also, do not exercise to the point you are sweating heavily.**

Your brows may look a little red and swollen for the first two days following your procedure. Then they will get itchy as they start to heal. **IT'S VERY IMPORTANT THAT YOU DO NOT ITCH THEM!** You can tap them lightly with the pad of your finger to alleviate the itchiness.

Microblading is a two-step process- you will have a follow up appointment four weeks after the first. On the second appointment, we will add more hair strokes and decide if the color is good or you would like your brows a little darker or lighter. We can adjust the shape, color, and density of the brows during this second visit.

Brows may get spotty or striped looking as they heal and start to get dry and peel, **this is normal**. As they fade, they will become two to three shades lighter in color. You can fill in with shadow or soft brow pencil until they finish peeling within one to two weeks. Any thin or bare spots you end up with **ARE NORMAL** and will be filled in and corrected during your second procedure. The pigment takes much better during this second appointment and your brows will be perfect after their second healing.

Our microblading fee is \$450.00. This covers your consultation, should you desire one, and both appointments. The \$450.00 is due in full following your first service. We accept cash or check.

Remember, this is a semi permanent tattoo-, which means about every six to 18 months you will want a touch up. The cost of touch up within this time frame is \$250.00. Brows will fade, everyone is different depending on skin type and how well you take care of them.

You can help your brows to last longer by always applying sunscreen when tanning. Also, avoid your eyebrows when using retinols or dermabrasions. Our pigments are plant based so they will fade faster than regular tattoo inks. The good news is they have no iron oxides like tattoo inks and won't fade to blue, purple, and pink. They will simply get lighter.
